Eligibility:

- Students who qualify are third through fifth graders in public school who scored a 1 or 2 on the third or fourth grade English Language Arts section of the Florida Standards Assessment in **Spring 2019**.
- Applications are processed on a first-come, first-served basis in the order all documents are received. Students who are classified as English Language Learners, and who are enrolled in a program or receiving services that are specifically designed to meet the instructional needs of English Language Learner students, will receive priority.

Reminders:

- You may still use any funds remaining in your student’s account from the 2018-19 school year. If your student is awarded a scholarship for 2019-20, an additional \$500 will be placed in their account.

- To successfully complete the application, you will need the following information which can be found on your student’s **Spring 2019** Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) report (see sample below to find the needed information):
 1. Your student’s grade level at the time of the Spring 2019 Florida Standards Assessment.
 2. Your student’s Florida Education Identifier (FLEID) number.
 3. The Department of Education School Choice Code for the school your student attended and was administered the Spring 2019 Florida Standards Assessment.
 4. The school district ID number. (Note: This is typically a two-digit number.)
 5. Your student’s Spring 2019 Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) English Language Arts (ELA) performance level.
 6. Your student’s Spring 2019 Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) English Language Arts (ELA) score.

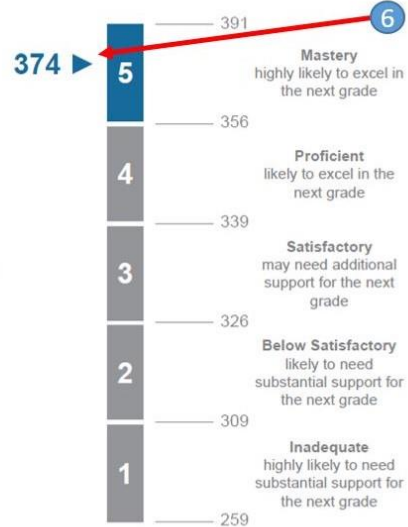
PERFORMANCE LEVEL
