

Plan for New Content

The Hendry County School District is committed to ensuring that its website is accessible to people with disabilities. Our website will comply with Section 504 and Title II which require the prohibition of individuals being denied benefits or otherwise being subject to discrimination on the basis of a disability.

- This policy shall apply to all new, updated, and existing web content on the District Website www.hendry-schools.org and any school websites located on the District domain.
- The District will provide annual training to all individuals authorized to add new or update existing web content. Individuals that have not been through this training will not be authorized to add new content or update existing content.
- The District will ensure that third party content providers are aware of our web accessibility policy.
- All areas of the District's website will be reviewed annually using appropriate Website Accessibility Conformance Evaluation Methodology. This annual evaluation shall be the responsibility of the Information Technology Department with assistance from appropriately qualified outside vendors.
- The annual evaluation will apply to the District's on line web content and any content developed by, maintained, or offered through a third party vendor.
- Third party vendors of website templates will be required to provide the District with information that their template will comply with accessibility requirements for disabled individuals.
- Our website will meet W3C WAI Web Content Accessibility Guidelines 2.0, Level AA conformance.
