

TENTATIVE MINUTES
Hendry County School Board
Regular Meeting
Tuesday, September 18, 2018

The Hendry County School Board met in Regular Session beginning at 5:30 p.m. in the School Board Meeting Room, Hendry Co. Courthouse, 2nd Fl., 25 E. Hickpochee, LaBelle, FL. Those in attendance were: Jon Basquin, Chairman; Dwayne E. Brown, Vice Chairman; Sally Berg and Amanda Nelson, Members; and Paul K. Puletti, Superintendent.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Basquin.

Pledge & Invocation – Chairman Basquin led the Board and guests in the Lord's Prayer and the Salute to the U. S. Flag.
